



Still Confident

PSALM 27 *Of David.*

- 1 The LORD is my light and my salvation—
whom shall I fear?
The LORD is the stronghold of my life—
of whom shall I be afraid?
- 2 When evil men advance against me
to devour my flesh,
when my enemies and my foes attack me,
they will stumble and fall.
- 3 Though an army besiege me,
my heart will not fear;
though war break out against me,
even then will I be confident.
- 4 One thing I ask of the LORD,
this is what I seek:
that I may dwell in the house of the LORD
all the days of my life,
to gaze upon the beauty of the LORD
and to seek him in his temple.
- 5 For in the day of trouble
he will keep me safe in his dwelling;
he will hide me in the shelter of his tabernacle
and set me high upon a rock.
- 6 Then my head will be exalted
above the enemies who surround me;
at his tabernacle will I sacrifice with shouts of joy;
I will sing and make music to the LORD.
- 7 Hear my voice when I call, O LORD;
be merciful to me and answer me.
- 8 My heart says of you, “Seek his face!”
Your face, LORD, I will seek.
- 9 Do not hide your face from me,
do not turn your servant away in anger;
you have been my helper.
Do not reject me or forsake me,
O God my Savior.
- 10 Though my father and mother forsake me,
the LORD will receive me.
- 11 Teach me your way, O LORD;
lead me in a straight path
because of my oppressors.
- 12 Do not turn me over to the desire of my foes,
for false witnesses rise up against me,
breathing out violence.
- 13 **I am still confident of this:**
I will see the goodness of the LORD
in the land of the living.
- 14 Wait for the LORD;
be strong and take heart
and wait for the LORD.

Calculate the pressures

▼ *Personal adversaries?*

- 2 When evil men advance against me to devour my flesh, when my enemies and my foes attack me

▼ *Powerful armies?*

- 3 Though an army besiege me...though war break out against me

▼ *Painful abandonment?*

- 10 Though my father and mother forsake me

▼ *Perjurious accusations?*

- 12 False witnesses rise up against me, breathing out violence.

Continue to pray

▼ *Get to the house of God*

- 4 One thing I ask of the LORD, this is what I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life
- 4 To gaze upon the beauty of the LORD and to seek him in his temple.
- 8 My heart says of you, “Seek his face!” Your face, LORD I will seek.

▼ *Grab onto the help of God*

- 7 Hear my voice when I call, O LORD; be merciful to me and answer me.
- 9 Do not hide your face from me, do not turn your servant away in anger; you have been my helper.
- 9 Do not reject me or forsake me, O God my Savior.
- 12 Do not turn me over to the desire of my foes.

▼ *Get onto the highway of God*

- 11 Teach me your way, O LORD; lead me in a straight path because of my oppressors.

Confess and prevail

▼ *Enunciate your faith*

● **I will not fear**

- 1 The LORD is my light and my salvation—whom shall I fear?
- 1 The LORD is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid?
- 3 My heart will not fear...even then will I be confident.

● **I will not be forsaken**

- 5 For in the day of trouble he will keep me safe in his dwelling...
- 5 He will hide me in the shelter of his tabernacle and set me high upon a rock.
- 10 The LORD will receive me.

● **I will not fall**

- 2 Evil men...my enemies and my foes...will stumble and fall.
- 6 Then my head will be exalted above the enemies who surround me

● **I will not forfeit the favor of the Father**

Not in the here

- 13 I am still confident of this: I will see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.

Nor in the hereafter

- Hebrews 10:35 So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded.

● **I will not forget**

- 6 At his tabernacle will I sacrifice with shouts of joy; I will sing and make music to the LORD.

- 14 Wait for the LORD; be strong and take heart and wait for the LORD.
