First Century Antioch

capital of Roman province of Syria

world's third largest city, after Rome and Alexandria

first-century population estimates from 500,000 to 750,000

15 miles from the Mediterranean coast, but accessible via the Orontes River; a major trade center and cultural crossroads

Greek paganism prevailed, but a large Jewish population also thrived

300 miles north of Jerusalem

would become the center of world missions for first-century Christianity

The Antioch Prayer Services

1. They were gathered as a group

Acts 13:1 In the church at Antioch there were prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen (who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch) and Saul.

- ▲ The leaders were there
- ▲ The laity were there

2. They were waiting in worship

Acts 13:2 While they were worshiping the Lord

- ▲ They were lingering in the Lord's presence
- ▲ They were loving the Lord with their prayers and praises
- ▲ They were listening for the Lord's priorities and purposes

3. They were fasting from food

Acts 13:2 While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting,

- ▲ Fasting is forfeiture
- ▲ Fasting is for focusing

4. They were sensitive to the Spirit's speaking

Acts 13:2 While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them."

- ▲ The Holy Spirit spoke in the context of sound doctrine
- ▲ The Holy Spirit spoke with clarity and spiritual direction

5. They launched out at the Lord's leading

Acts 13:3 So after they had fasted and prayed, they placed their hands on them and sent them off.

- ▲ The Lord spoke to them inside the church
- ▲ The Lord sent them outside the church

The Antioch Prayer Strategies

- 1. We must worship God passionately as a unified body of believers when we gather for church.
- 2. We must lay aside distractions and hindrances and enter quickly and fully into God's presence.
- 3. We must each recognize the importance of our own individual spiritual investment into the services.
- 4. We must welcome the Holy Spirit's personal presence and work in our services-and surrender to Him.
- 5. We must learn that our assemblies are for ministering to the Lord as well as receiving ministry from Him.
- 6. We must pray for fresh power, fresh gifts, fresh vision, and fresh direction for our lives and our church.
- 7. We must pray that our experience in church will change our daily lives outside the church.
