Luke 5:1-11

 One day as Jesus was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret, with the people crowding around him and listening to the word of God,
 he saw at the water's edge two boats, left there by the fishermen, who were washing their nets. 3 He got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat.

4 When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch." 5 Simon answered, "Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. But because you say so, I will let down the nets." 6 When they had done so, they caught such a large number of fish that their nets began to break. 7 So they signaled their partners in the other boat to come and help them, and they came and filled both boats so full that they began to sink.

- ▲ Peter deployed

- ▲ Favor made the difference
- ▲ Fullness marked the day

3. The calling clarified

They responded with astonishment

They received an awesome assignment

They responded with absolute abandon

11 So they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed him.

Messages from the Miracle

- 1. Lingering and listening to Jesus exposes us to adventurous assignments --- so come up close!
- 2. Jesus' authority always exceeds our expertise so defer to his corrections and redirections!
- 3. The Lord's longitude/latitude is the location of blessing so launch out even when it takes you further!
- 4. The favor of the Lord transforms the mundane into the miraculous so don't frustrate his favor!
- 5. People are the pressing priority of Jesus so don't be afraid to accept his people projects!
