



## *1. The snow points to God's creative power and authority!*

Job 37:5 God's voice thunders in marvelous ways; he does great things beyond our understanding. 6 He says to the **snow**, 'Fall on the earth,' and to the rain shower, 'Be a mighty downpour.'

Psalms 147:15 He sends his command to the earth; his word runs swiftly. 16 He spreads the **snow** like wool and scatters the frost like ashes. 17 He hurls down his hail like pebbles. Who can withstand his icy blast? 18 He sends his word and melts them; he stirs up his breezes, and the waters flow.

## *2. The snow participates in the universal praises of God!*

Psalms 148:7 Praise the LORD from the earth, you great sea creatures and all ocean depths, 8 lightning and hail, **snow** and clouds, stormy winds that do his bidding, 9 you mountains and all hills, fruit trees and all cedars, 10 wild animals and all cattle, small creatures and flying birds, 11 kings of the earth and all nations, you princes and all rulers on earth, 12 young men and maidens, old men and children. 13 Let them praise the name of the LORD, for his name alone is exalted; his splendor is above the earth and the heavens.

## *3. The snow points to God's pleasure in forgiving sin completely!*

Isaiah 1:18 "Come now, let us reason together," says the LORD. "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as **snow**; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool.

Psalms 51:7 Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow.

## *4. The snow paints a picture of God's powerful and refreshing Word!*

Isaiah 55:10 As the rain and the **snow** come down from heaven, and do not return to it without watering the earth and making it bud and flourish, so that it yields seed for the sower and bread for the eater, 11 so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it.

Proverbs 25:13 Like the coolness of **snow** at harvest time is a trustworthy messenger to those who send him; he refreshes the spirit of his masters.

## *5. The snow points to the radiance of Jesus when we shall see him!*

Daniel 7:9 "As I looked, thrones were set in place, and the Ancient of Days took his seat. His clothing was as white as **snow**; the hair of his head was white like wool. His throne was flaming with fire, and its wheels were all ablaze. 10 A river of fire was flowing, coming out from before him. Thousands upon thousands attended him; ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him.

Revelation 1:14 I turned around to see the voice that was speaking to me. And when I turned I saw seven golden lampstands, 13 and among the lampstands was someone "like a son of man," dressed in a robe reaching down to his feet and with a golden sash around his chest. 14 His head and hair were white like wool, as white as **snow**, and his eyes were like blazing fire. 15 His feet were like bronze glowing in a furnace, and his voice was like the sound of rushing waters. 16 In his right hand he held seven stars, and out of his mouth came a sharp double-edged sword. His face was like the sun shining in all its brilliance.
